UTAH FACT SHEET

- The McWane Ductile Utah (MDU) facility has operated in its existing location since 1926.
- Represented by United Steelworkers (USW) Local 1654, which ratified a new 4 year contract in February 2021.
- Currently employs 325 people, who in 2022 produced and shipped more than 96,000 tons of Ductile iron pipe and pole sections for water systems and electrical infrastructure.
- Only Ductile iron pipe foundry located in the Intermountain West. Primary markets are Arizona, California and Washington.



ECONOMICS

- Sales volume were at historical records in 2022. 2022 sales are expected to surpass 2022 as funding from the Infrastructure Investment and Job Acts (IIUA) will start in 2023.
- Capital investments in 2022 and 2023 will exceed \$24 million.

ECONOMIC IMPACT

- Purchasing of scrap metal averaged 66,000 tons (\$25 million) per year over the past 5 years, making McWane Ductile-Utah one of the top metal recyclers in the western United States.
- \$14 million average salaries and wages paid to employees each year over the last five years.
- 21.5 million around expenditures over the past 5 years to purchase a wide range of goods and services. Key suppliers are industrial contractors, machine shops, and equipment / part OEM.
- 3.3 million annual average costs for natural gas and electricity over the past 5 years.
- Over \$64 million annual average economic impact for the last five years.

COMMUNITY

- Through the McWane Ductile Utah Giving Program consisting of an advisory committee of senior plant staff, the company distributes charitable contributions and sponsorships averaging \$50,000 annually to numerous and various community organizations such as:
